Quick context: We are starting our 1st MS-AT cohort Summer 1 2020, and we have one BS-AT to teach out in 2020-2021.

We started with Plan A (summer 1 online) and Plan B (summer 1 & 2 online). We have been told it is Plan B, with whispers that the Fall may be affected, but just whispers for now. Below is our current plan (both summer sessions online):

- Our original plan was to start our 1st MS-AT cohort with orientation, including ECC (CPR, etc.) on May 22 and begin Gross and Functional Anatomy courses on May 26 in Summer 1.
- We moved orientation online, and ECC (CPR, etc) to August before they start their 1st clinical in the Fall.
- We moved a course that is "easier" to convert online, Principles of EBP, from the Fall to Summer 1 (the only online class they take in Summer 1).
- We moved Gross Anatomy to Summer 2, where they will take the 1st portion online. We are requesting an 2-week extension of the course to 8/14/20; Fall begins 8/17/20. When we are allowed to have students on campus, hopefully by 7/27/20, at least by 8/1/20, we would complete the hands-on portion of the course.
- The same procedure above for Gross would apply to a Principles of Injury Prevention course in Summer 2. This course was already in Summer 2 and was supposed to prepare them for the mini-immersive clinical below.
- We moved their 1st mini-immersive clinical (a 3 week, pre-season, high patient volume clinical) from Year 1 Summer 2 to Year 2 Summer 2, because athletics doesn't not know if pre-season will be allowed yet, and students would not be able to attend the clinical because we are hopefully finishing the hands-on content of the Summer 2 courses above.
- We split the 2-credit Functional Anatomy (palpation and functional assessment) course (originally held in Summer 1) into 2 1-credit Special Topics courses: Functional Anatomy 1 in the Fall, taked in conjuction with our Examination, Diagnosis, Treatment 1 (EDT 1) course. Functional Anatomy 2 in the Spring with EDT 2.
- We re-checked faculty load as we were finalizing this plan to see if there were any issues for 2020-2021.

Clear as mud, right?? Our Dean is seeking input from admin on the possibility of extending the Summer 2 courses. We had already changed the course dates of the Summer 2 minimmersive clinical course from 7/27/20 - 8/14/20 to match up with pre-season, so the date changes have been approved in the past.

Problem is, we just do not know when students will be allowed on campus. When we know that, we'll likely have to adjust the plan again. Let me know if you have any questions. Feel free to share.
