The AATE seeks applicants for 2 members Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee. The DEI Committee is made up of individuals who can assist institutional members through educational initiatives that support the AATE commitment diversity, equity, inclusion, and social justice.

The DEI Committee is charged with identifying, prioritize, and recommending educational strategies to promote diversity, equity, inclusion, and social justice. The group is charged to:

1. Provide programming that supports educators' efforts to support marginalized and minority students and educators who are members of the black, indigenous, people of color and LGBTQI+ communities.
2. Provide academic and financial resources to support diverse students during the application process, the first semester and continuing on through their residency or degree program.
3. Investigate a mentoring program for diverse students to help navigate their progression through the professional program and the profession.
4. Identify future educational and supportive endeavors.
5. Collaborate with the Faculty Development Committee as needed.

Duration of appointment: Start date of July 1, 2023 for a 2-year term. This term can be renewed once.

Time Commitment: 1 – 2 hours per week for committee members
