The Association for Athletic Training Education (AATE) seeks applicants for 2 new members of the Faculty Development Committee (FDC). The FDC works to identify, organize, and facilitate delivery of continuing education that is relevant to athletic training faculty. The committee has this broad scope of work:

- Create and facilitate delivery of programming to meet continuing education needs of the AATE community
- Organize and deliver a robust faculty development program to facilitate success in the academic community
- Create a resource repository and a maintenance strategy for the AATE community

The FDC currently supports 2 major projects: the [Foundations-to-Instruction Series](#) of continuing education courses and the [AATE Faculty Institute](#), a year-long cohort-based program designed to support AT faculty in their career development and promote excellence and innovation in AT education.

Duration of appointment: Start date of July 1, 2023 for a 2-year term. This term can be renewed once.

Time Commitment: 1 – 2 hours per week for committee members
