

Committee Charter

COMMITTEE TITLE: FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

COMMITTEE COMPOSITION: 4 - 6 members (must have at least 1 representative from professional program and 1 representative from a DAT program and 1 representative from a residency program); 1 Board liaison

BACKGROUND (context for the work of the committee)

The AATE serves faculty in athletic training education programs at professional and post-professional levels. Continuing education, both in athletic training-specific content and pedagogy/andragogy, is central to on-going personal and programmatic growth. In its April 2020 report, the Faculty Development: Learning and Teaching Curricular Content Work Group identified a prioritized list of educational opportunities and recommended creation of an information portal and development of face-to-face and online learning activities. Recognizing the ongoing need for information and programming, the Faculty Development Committee (FDC) has been created to identify, organize, and facilitate delivery of continuing education that is relevant to athletic training faculty.

SCOPE OF WORK (focused and task-oriented)

The committee will:

- 1. Create and facilitate delivery of programming to meet continuing education needs of AATE community
- 2. Create and launch a robust faculty development program to facilitate success in the academic community
- 3. Create a resource repository and a maintenance strategy for the AATE community

ANTICIPATED COMMITMENT

Start Date: May 1, 2021 End Date: Based on initial appointment length

Time Commitment:1-2 hours per week for committee members; committee chair – includes biweekly board meetings, meeting preparation, and other engagement opportutnities

DELIVERABLES

- 1. Continuing education plan for the next 24 months
 - a. Committee members will have either a 12- month or 24-month initial appointment (renewable by mutual agreement one) to facilitate staggering of the committee
- 2. Develop and maintain resource repository.
 - a. Criteria for inclusion in and removal from the repository
 - b. Criteria for attribution

REPORTING PLAN

The Chair of the FDC will serve on the Board of Directors.

SUPPORTING RESOURCES

Resources will be provided on an as-needed basis.
