COMMITTEE TITLE: INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

COMMITTEE COMPOSITION: 5-7 members; 1 Board liaison

BACKGROUND

The AATE is committed to supporting high-quality, inclusive educational environments and equal opportunity for students and educators. As educators and health care providers, we are in a unique position to strengthen access, belonging, and student success across athletic training education and prepare future professionals to serve diverse communities. We want to gather individuals who can assist institutional members through educational initiatives and resources that are open and available to all.

SCOPE OF WORK

This committee will identify, prioritize, and recommend educational strategies that support inclusive learning environments, access to educational opportunity, student success, and professional preparation. Specifically, the group will:

1. Develop and/or provide programming that supports educators' efforts to create welcoming and effective learning environments for all students and educators.
2. Provide academic and financial resource information to support students during the application process, the first semester and continuing through their residency or degree program.
3. Investigate a mentoring program to help students navigate their progression through the professional program and the profession.
4. Identify future educational and supportive endeavors.
5. Collaborate with other Committees as needed

Committee programming and resources are intended to be open to eligible participants without preference or limitation based on race, sex, ethnicity, national origin, or other protected status, consistent with applicable law.
